Instructions for Installation and Use

IMPORTANT: KEEP THIS SHEET IN THE PLACE PROVIDED ON THE CHILD RESTRAINT



PRODUCT INFORMATION

WARNING

No child restraint can guarantee absolute protection from injury in every crash. However, to ensure that your child gets all the protection designed into the Child Booster Cushion. CAREFULLY READ ALL THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLATION. IN THE EVENT OF DOUBT ABOUT THE METHOD OF INSTALLATION, CONSULT BRITAX CHILDCARE OR AGENT OR A CHILD RESTRAINT FITTING STATION AUTHORIZED BY A RELEVANT TRANSPORT AUTHORITY OR, IN NEW ZEALAND, THE AGENT FOR THE VEHICLE.

DO NOT USE WITH JUST A LAP BELT. You must use with a lap-sash seat belt or with a seat belt and child harness.

Use the restraint exactly as shown in the instructions.

DO NOT LEAVE CHILDREN UNATTENDED IN THE CAR. Supervision of children is needed because they may be able to undo the buckles.

Do not alter or modify this restraint. Repairs must only be done by the manufacturer or agent. Do not allow the restraint to come into contact with polishes, oils, bleach and other chemicals. Destroy the restraint if it has been in a severe crash, even if no damage is visible.

If used with a child harness, the lap strap of the seat belt must be adjusted firmly first, and then the harness, so that the lap strap is not lifted off the child's lap when the harness is adjusted.

Do not use seat belt extenders, even if the car seat belt is not long enough to secure the child restraint.

DO NOT USE THIS RESTRAINT IF THE CHILD'S EYE LEVEL IS ABOVE THE TOP OF THE CAR SEAT BACK OR HEADREST WHEN THE CHILD IS SEATED ON THE CHILD RESTRAINT. CHECK THAT THIS CHILD RESTRAINT WILL FIT YOUR CAR.

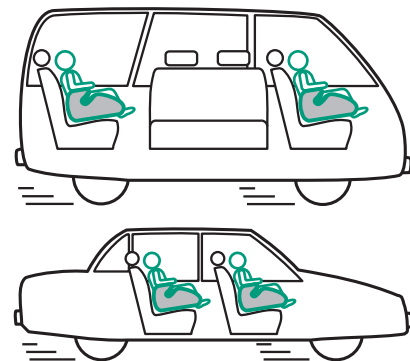
DO NOT USE THIS RESTRAINT WITHOUT THE COVER.

DO NOT USE A CHILD RESTRAINT IN A SEATING POSITION WHERE AN AIR BAG IS FITTED. FOLLOW THE CAR MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDATIONS.

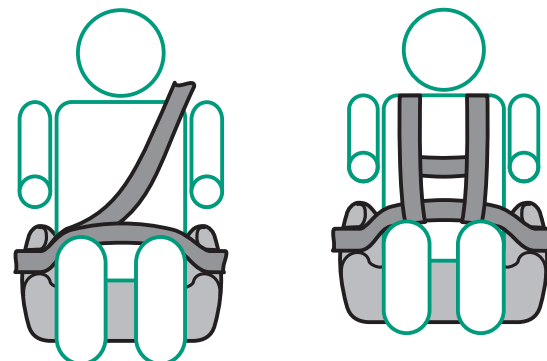

SUITABLE FOR USE



THIS RESTRAINT MUST BE USED IN CARS WITH FORWARD FACING SEATS WITH A LAP-SASH SEAT BELT OR WITH A SEAT BELT AND CHILD HARNESS.



To be used only with lap-sash seat belt or with a seat belt and child harness for a child weighing from **14kg to 26kg**.



NOT SUITABLE FOR USE

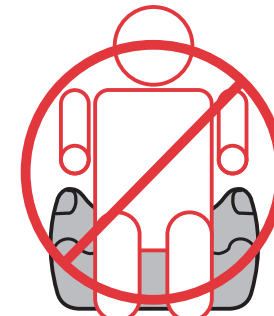


Do not use on any vehicle seat which faces sideways or rearwards.

HOW TO USE & INSTALL

WITH LAP-SASH SEAT BELT (front & rear seat outboard positions)

1. Fit the Child Booster Cushion as illustrated.
2. Engage seat belt buckle and tongue. If the seat belt buckle is adjustable, adjust the buckle as low as possible away from the child.
3. Adjust the lap and sash portion of the seat belt firmly but comfortably across the lap and chest.
4. If using an Inertia Reel Retractor seat belt, adjust lap portion of the seat belt firmly around the child and Child Booster Cushion, then let the slack sash portion retract up into sash retractor.
5. If possible, adjust the vehicle seat to improve the position of the sash on the child's chest.



WITH APPROVED CHILD SAFETY HARNESS (rear seat positions only)

1. Fit the Child Booster Cushion as illustrated.
2. Adjust harness correctly around the child as instructed by the harness manufacturer. Ensure that the lap belt passes under the two side arms of the Child Booster Cushion.
3. Engage seat belt buckle and tongue. If the seat belt buckle is adjustable, adjust the buckle as low as possible away from the child.
4. The harness must fit firmly but comfortably across the lap and chest. Once adjusted, no further adjustment is necessary except to accommodate for the child's growth.



WASHING INSTRUCTIONS ARE ON THE COVER. ONLY USE THE BOOSTER SEAT WITH THE COVER FITTED. CEASE USE OF THE BOOSTER CUSHION IF THE MOULDING IS BROKEN.



IN CASE OF ACCIDENT

If your restraint has been involved in a severe crash, you should destroy the restraint even if no damage is obvious. Some insurance companies offer vehicle insurance which covers or partially covers the replacement of your child restraint. Contact your insurance company for further details.

Your insurance company may require you to keep the child restraint for assessment, but do not use the child restraint after a severe crash. To assist you in making an accident insurance claim cut the following statement and include it with your claim.

NOTICE TO INSURANCE COMPANY CHILD RESTRAINT INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT

All **safe-n-sound** child restraints are manufactured to Australian/New Zealand Standards AS/NZS 1754-2004 which require us to advise users of child restraints to "Destroy the entire restraint if it has been in use in a severe crash, even if no damage is obvious". The joint Australian/New Zealand Standards committee CS/85, advise that the statement applies whether a child was in the child restraint or not. A severe crash, we consider as being one where the main body structure of the vehicle is distorted.

There is no method of determining if the restraint has been damaged and we concur with the Australian/New Zealand Standards in recommending destruction of the child restraint.

This notice is to advise you of the requirements of the Australian/New Zealand Standards and our obligation in complying with the standards.

Please assist the owner of this restraint in their claim.
